Maths	White Rose Maths Curriculum is used for maths in KS1. Elements of White Rose are used to support the Maths Early learning goals.
English	The Literacy Tree Curriculum is followed: Books and units from Writing Roots main curriculum is used in KS1. The Cornerstones Maestro curriculum and its linked texts are used as a basis for English in EYFS.
Science	Cornerstones Maestro Curriculum is used for Science, Geography, History, Art, and Design Technology at KS1. It is also used to support the EYFS learning goals. This is through a range of main driver projects in a focused curriculum area with appropriate cross curricular links. Smaller supplementary projects to support topics are built into each half term.
